MAINTAIN INTEGRITY - Require voter ID when voting in person or by absentee (A.6111)

PROVIDE SECURITY - Create a School Resource Officer Program and establish a resource officer education grant to reimburse schools outside of NYC for the hiring of a school resource officer (A.2023)

REQUIRE TRANSPARENCY - Necessitate an explanation by both PSC and NYSERDA of the state's mandated energy efficiency programs. (A.7263)
