IT'S TIME TO PRIORITIZE PUBLIC SAFETY



KEEPING OFFENDERS ACCOUNTABLE

Age is not a defense for violent offenses, and 16 and 17-year old offenders should not be protected by Family Court for acts of significant violence (A.4705)



PENALIZING THREATS OF HARM

Those accused of threatening harm when charged with hate crimes and making terroristic threats must be allowed to be held on bail (A.8283 of 2024)



STRICTER PAROLE TIME

We're looking to extend the length of parole consideration periods for particularly violent offenders (A.8259 of 2024)



CRACKING DOWN ON FALSE REPORTING

"Swatting" is a disturbing trend that must be stopped for the sake of the community and for law enforcement departments that waste their time and resources responding to these fake calls (A.1345)



OBSTRUCTING AN OFFICER

Law enforcement professionals need to be respected when on the job, and intentionally obstructing them from performing their official duties adds undue risk that should not be tolerated (A.3329)
