We have some ideas.



JUDICIAL DISCRETION

We can trust in our judges to set bail if they see an offender has a history of breaking the law (A.4155)



EVALUATE DANGEROUSNESS

We can empower justices to consider individual and community safety when determining pre-trial release for suspects (A.4206)



PUNISH GUN OFFENDERS

Gun crimes should keep offenders off the street, which is not what New York established in 2019² (A.632)



HATE AND TERROR CRIMES

We can ensure that hate crimes and terror threats are charged as hate crimes (A.8283 of 2024)
