## 2024-25 NYS Budget Snapshot...<sup>1,2,3</sup>

### • Non-resident Migrant Assistance: \$2.4 billion



- Department of Veterans Services: \$33.9 million
- Homeless Funding across OTDA/OCFS/IOLA: \$452.6 million
- Empire State Supportive Housing: \$210 million
- Mortgage Insurance Fund/homelessness: \$53.6 million
- Office for the Aging: \$395.5 million
- Local Government Assistance: \$778.9 million
- Economic Development and Gov't Oversight: \$2.3 billion

## SCOTT HAS A PLAN TO HELP LOCAL FAMILIES

- Prevent schools, daycare centers and youth community organization buildings from being transitioned into shelters.<sup>4</sup>
- Audit state and federal migrant funds to guard against waste and inefficiencies.<sup>5</sup>
- Require the state to register all migrants to assist with background checks and monitoring of refugees seeking asylum.<sup>6</sup>
- Provide tax relief for **families** on gas and groceries.<sup>7</sup>
- Provide tax relief for our **seniors** by capping the amount they pay in property taxes.<sup>8</sup>
- Support veterans' services organizations by establishing the Veterans' Services Organization Capital Support Program.<sup>9</sup>
