Assemblyman Santabarbara supports legislation to:

- ▶ **Crack down on harassment** and intimidation among students, including bullying that occurs online (A.1985)
- ▶ **Discourage cyberbullying** by creating programs in schools that promote civility on the Internet (A.2518)
- ▶ **Provide training** for school bus drivers in the detection and discouragement of bullying (A.5687)

Encourage kids to tell a trusted adult if they see someone being bullied

Urge kids to help others who are being bullied by showing kindness
