A 5-point plan that can make a difference for thousands of families.

OPPORTUNITIES
Communication support in addition to vocational rehabilitation services to improve employment outcomes for job-seekers with autism spectrum disorder.

COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION
An Autism Advisory Board to create, implement and update a statewide Autism Action Plan that monitors and incorporates new information as it becomes available.

EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION
A new, first-of-its kind optional Autism I.D. Card to assist in interactions with law enforcement and first responders.

HOUSING
An Autism Home Loan program that keeps people connected to their community - available to family members for the construction of long-term, need-specific housing.

ACCESS TO INFORMATION
A Communication & Technology Bill of Rights that would give people with disabilities better access to technology and information.
