FIND OUT HOW TO GET YOUR HARD-EARNED MONEY BACK!



Businesses and organizations are required to report forgotten money to the Office of the State Comptroller when they cannot locate the owner. Types of unclaimed funds include lost paychecks, bank accounts, insurance benefits, utility bills, and stocks. There are over 35,000 documented accounts of unclaimed funds in the 112th Assembly District and you **may** be one of them.

HERE'S HOW TO SEE IF YOU HAVE ANY UNCLAIMED FUNDS IN YOUR NAME:

- Go to the Office of the New York State Comptroller at: https://www.osc.state.ny.us/ouf
- 2 Click the Orange Button that says "Search Now."
- Follow the prompts to see if you have unclaimed funds. If so they will ask questions to **confirm your identity such as previous addresses or employers**.



ONCE YOU'VE CONFIRMED YOUR IDENTITY THE COMPTROLLER'S OFFICE WILL PUT A CHECK FOR YOU IN THE MAIL.
