Improving motorist and pedestrian safety

To help maintain safe roadways, Assemblywoman Woerner secured \$125,000 in funding for the Village of Victory to purchase a truck, tractor and a snow blower for their Department of Public Works. Woerner is also in the process of securing a \$50,000 grant to construct sidewalks along Spring Street and Pearl Street.

Supporting public parks

Safe, enjoyable recreational spaces are a valuable aspect of any community, and Saratoga is no exception. Assemblywoman Woerner is working to obtain a \$125,000 grant to help the Village of Schuylerville install a splash pad at Fort Hardy Park.

Building up our communities

- Assemblywoman Woerner secured \$125,000 to construct a boat launch on the Saratoga Lake waterfront.
- Furthermore, she has committed to securing \$250,000 for the Historic Hudson-Hoosic Rivers Partnership to assist with the construction of the Champlain Canal Region Gateway Visitors Center. This center will provide a space for visitors to learn the history of the Revolutionary War and serve as an orientation point for visitors to explore the surrounding communities.

Supporting our medical infrastructure

The General Schuyler Emergency Squad is an invaluable community resource, providing critical pre-hospital health care services to the residents of Saratoga communities. To aid these hardworking first responders, Assemblywoman Woerner secured \$10,000 in 2018 that enabled the squad to upgrade their advanced airway management capabilities.

Investing in Saratoga schools and libraries

Assemblywoman Woerner is committed to ensuring Saratoga students get the high-quality education they deserve. She secured \$200,000 in additional funding for Schuylerville schools. She also secured \$5,000 for the Schuylerville Public Library to install automatic door openers and purchase an iPad.
