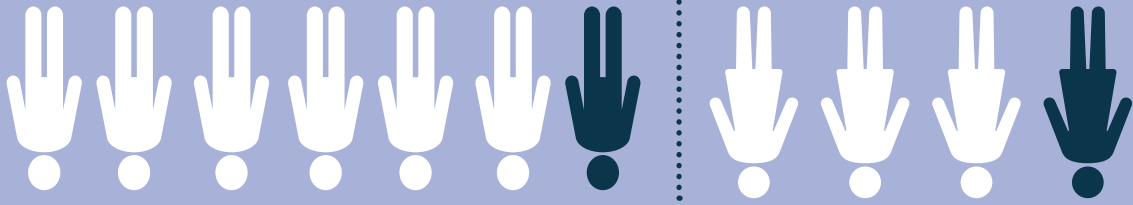

Sponsoring Gabby's Law:

Named in honor of Gabby Petito, the 22-year-old New Yorker whose heartbreaking disappearance and subsequent murder by her boyfriend gripped the nation in 2022, "Gabby's Law" aims to streamline the reporting process for such cases. This legislation seeks to raise awareness and enhance the likelihood of locating missing individuals, while also enabling New York State to become part of an established national alert program for missing persons (A.3230).
