By applying his expertise from the private sector to his responsibilities as a public policymaker, Matt has consistently demonstrated unwavering support for the small businesses that lend our communities their distinctive charm and provide the backbone of our region's economy.

- Implement the "New York Business Emergency Relief Act of 2023" to help pay debt owed to the federal Unemployment Insurance Trust Fund (A.6068).
- Strengthen economic development by allowing cideries to ship directly to consumers, cementing New York as an industry leader in cider (A.3912).
- Expand opportunities for service-disabled veterans and make permanent the "Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Act" (A.4577).
- Create tax credits for producing a certain percentage of their products in New York (A.2954).
- Establish tax-deferred savings accounts that may be used during times of emergency (A.2087).
