ASSEMBLYMAN BILLY JONES secured critical resources for local veterans

Assemblyman Jones helped pass a state budget that:

- Provides \$5 million to expand the Joseph P. Dwyer Veterans Peer Support Project, which is a peer-to-peer program that helps veterans struggling with post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and traumatic brain injury (TBI)
- ✓ Provides \$100,000 to help the North Country Veterans Association (NCVA) continue to serve veterans and their families in Clinton, Essex and Franklin counties

- Reestablishes the state Division of Veterans' Services existing call-in line to connect veterans directly to Veterans Benefit Advisors
- ✓ Extends tuition benefits for eligible members of NYS's military forces to attend college in New York State for five years
- Extends the Hire-A-Vet tax credit for two additional years, which offers a tax credit to employers who hire veterans
