# Assemblywoman Buttenschon: Helping build safer, stronger communities

I helped secure significant statewide funding in the 2024-25 state budget that will benefit the Mohawk Valley, including:

- ✓ **\$60 million** for the Consolidated Local Street and Highway Improvement Program (CHIPs)
- ✓ **\$70 million** for nonpublic school safety
- ✓ **\$44 million** for new library construction
- ✓ **\$1.1 million** for SUNY Polytechnic Institute



I opposed the following budget provisions that would have negatively impacted the Mohawk Valley:

- X Allowing the Governor to close **5 New York State Correctional Facilities** with only 90 days of notification
- X Allocating **\$2.4 billion** to reimburse migrant costs in New York State due to inaction by the Federal Government
- X The inclusion of the **RAPID Act** and components of Good Cause Eviction
