ASSEMBLYWOMAN MARIANNE BUTTENSCHON: Check if you're eligible for HEAP benefits today

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) can help eligible New Yorkers heat and cool their homes. Eligibility and benefit amounts are based on income, household size, the primary heating source, age of household members and disability status.

If you are eligible, you may receive one regular HEAP benefit per year. Those who are in danger of running out of fuel or having their utility service shut off may also be eligible for emergency HEAP assistance.

HEAP may be able to help if you heat your home with:

- ✓ Electricity
- ✓ Natural Gas
- ✓ Oil
- ✓ Coal
- ✓ Propane
- ✓ Wood/Wood Pellets
- ✓ Kerosene
- ✓ Corn
