Broadband Access Is More Important Than Ever

Since representing the 101st Assembly District, Assemblyman Brian Miller has pushed for all New Yorkers to have access to high-speed broadband. While coverage has improved in the past few years, there are still thousands of people without broadband access.

For this reason, Brian has co-sponsored legislation to:

-  **Enact the Wireless Broadband Eligible Facility Permitting Act, which would provide regulation of wireless facilities (A.896)**
-  **Eliminate fees that the Department of Transportation assess on fiber optic utility companies (A.4197)**

Additionally, Brian has also supported legislation in this year's state budget to:

-  **Enact the Comprehensive Broadband Connectivity Act which, directs the New York Public Service Commission to review state broadband and fiber optic services (A.3006-C)**
