

Copenhagen Global Fashion Summit



I've recently returned from an incredible visit to Copenhagen, Denmark for the 2023 Global Fashion Summit where I was able to speak about and promote **The Fashion Sustainability and Accountability Act** (aka the Fashion Act) (A4333). This summit was a tremendous step in international cooperation as the European Union and the United States came together for the first time in a commitment to create compatible regulations for the fashion industry.

The fashion industry is responsible for 8% of greenhouse gas emissions worldwide and is one of the greatest polluters of water. This industry also has the second-highest rate of child labor in the world and is among the top

5 employers of slave labor. With the United States being the largest per capita consumer of textiles in the world, we cannot have a global solution to these serious problems without US participation.

The Fashion Act will require New York State fashion sellers to be accountable to environmental and social due diligence policies, enacting science-based regulations to reduce climate change and its negative effects, as well as addressing unethical labor practices. Companies found to be non-compliant will be fined, and the proceeds will be used to benefit workers and communities that have been harmed by the industry. These changes will make New York a leader in steering the industry toward a more sustainable and ethical future.

New Laws

Several new laws will be taking effect in New York State this July:

- My bill <u>A4903</u> Persons who suffer from a substance use disorder have the right to seek and receive services and treatment based on their gender identity/expression and/or sexual orientation.
- A1874 Private food service management companies must disclose ingredients and nutritional info for all the meals they provide school districts
- A10426 Community college students are allowed to apply for certificate of residence from counties via electronic means
- A8425 Concussion Management & Awareness Act requiring public/nonpublic schools to abide by concussion protocol.
- A.8169-A, A.2205, A.1741-A, A.3693 Two new laws to improve health insurance transparency and healthcare/pharmaceutical affordability
- <u>A.3008-C</u> The New York Youth Jobs Connector program is established to help un- and under-employed individuals ages 16-24 connect to educational, occupational and training services.
- A.41001 Firearms dealers and sellers are required to contact the State police to conduct background checks.

 A.887-C Human Trafficking recognition training is required at various state offices, including the Division of Criminal Justice Services, and the Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance.
