In a world of chaos, you deserve some peace, which is why I am fighting for:

-  **Raise the Age Reform (A.4705)**
Prevent 16- and 17-year-olds who commit serious felonies from escaping criminal liability in Family Court.
-  **Parole Reform (A.7532)**
Tightens parole rules so incarcerated individuals stay off the streets and victims' voices are prioritized in parole decisions.
-  **Corrections Officer Safety (A.5190)**
Protects corrections officers by replacing name tags with badge numbers – helping prevent inmates from tracking or targeting officers and their families.
-  **School Safety (A.6121)**
Ensures quicker protection for students and staff during school attacks by improving on-site security and response before police arrive.
-  **Tougher Penalties for First-Degree Rape (A.6159)**
Requires a minimum 10-year prison sentence for anyone convicted of first-degree rape – ensuring serious crimes get serious punishment.
