The 2016-17 state budget includes:

- \$12.9 million for the Jamesville-DeWitt School District - 7.01 percent more than last year
- Full repeal of the Gap Elimination Adjustment (GEA) to restore funding and preserve essential programs
- \$19 million in library construction aid a \$5 million increase – to preserve access to vital learning resources
