State Budget Invests in Infrastructure

- The 2017-18 state budget provides \$503 million in Consolidated Local Street and Highway Improvement Program (CHIPS) funds for municipalities to support the construction and repair of highways and bridges--an increase of \$65 million
- \$100 million through the PAVE NY program to assist municipalities with rehabilitation and reconstruction of local highways and roads
- \$2.5 billion for the replacement of aging water mains and sewer lines



State Fair Modernization: The 2017-18
Budget provides \$70 million in capital
funding to continue modernizing the
New York State Fairgrounds including
\$50 million for a multi-use Exposition
Center and other improvements and
\$20 million to construct a new on-ramp to I-690 West and
improvements to the State Fairgrounds' Orange parking lot.

Assemblyman Magnarelli also provided capital funding for the Town of Geddes for the following projects:

- \$250,000 for Lakeside Road resurfacing, the West High Terrace Drainage project and the Highway Department roof replacement project
- \$416,530 for resurfacing portions of various town streets including Ontario, Lake Country, Newcastle, Parsons, Fern and Helmi work is expected to begin next Spring
