A Time-Honored Tradition

Assemblyman Brian Manktelow knows that hunting is a long-standing tradition here in America, which is why he has advocated to help protect those who participate in this sport and help educate those looking to get involved or understand it. He has supported legislation to:



Provide fishing and hunting tax credits for members of the military who are stationed in New York (A.2067);



Allow those over the age of 62 or who are physically disabled to use a crossbow during long bow hunting season (A.3550);



Expand who is eligible for a non-ambulatory hunter permit to cover more handicapped individuals (A.4281);



Promote instruction on hunting, fishing, and outdoor education in physical education classes in high schools (A.6091);



Allow for the sale of two-day, non-resident hunting licenses by enacting the Come Home to Hunt Act (A.4369); and



Eliminate sporting license fees for honorably discharged and disabled veterans (A.4893).
