AS OUR ASSEMBLYMAN, *Brian Manktelow has proven he will fight for our communities here in Webster and Wayne County. Heading into the 2024 Legislative Session, Brian is working on the issues that matter to us most, including:*

- Lower Taxes: Cut state taxes on everyday essentials like cleaning products and personal care items (A.1690) and pet food (A.4244)
- Safer Communities: Allow judges to consider a defendant's public safety risk when determining release on bail (A.5992), enact "The Domestic Violence Protection Act - Helen's Law" requiring registration of violent felony offenders (A.3665) and establish the crimes of assault on a pregnant woman in the second degree as a class D felony and assault on a pregnant woman in the first degree as a class C felony (A.3604)
- Affordable Energy: Bring transparency to the fees that drive up energy costs to protect ratepayers (A.7263) and allow localities to ensure internet access to every citizen through the Regional Broadband Expansion & Access Program Act (A.4686)
- Prep for Success: Provide public and private school students with financial literacy education (A.2928) and allow schools to provide and sell whole milk and 2% milk in addition to existing skim and fat-free options (A.2321)
- Protect the Future of Our Farms: Extend eligibility for the agricultural property tax credit to farmers having a leasehold interest of at least five years in qualified agricultural property to provide tax relief for our agricultural industry as well as enhance farmland and open-space preservation (A.2040)
- Protect Homeownership: Raise the income cap for senior citizens applying for the Enhanced STAR property tax exemption (A.2769) and offer assistance in home purchasing for service-related disabled veterans (A.1990) as well as qualifying police officers, firefighters and teachers (A.4675)
- Voted against tax extenders on job-creating businesses and New York families (A.3009-C)
