Combat Veterans Healthcare Choice Program Act

Would allow combat veterans to set aside money tax-free to pay for healthcare while they wait for federal benefits. ¹

Veterans in Agriculture Program

Would help veterans start or grow careers in farming with training, mentorship, and outreach. ²

Expanding Care for Our Heroes

Would mandate the New York State Department of Health to conduct a comprehensive study on establishing three new veterans' nursing homes within the state. ³

Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy Program

Would create a treatment program for veterans suffering from traumatic brain injuries and PTSD. ⁴
