
## We must protect our borders to protect our communities.






## We need to end New York's status as a sanctuary state. Common sense needs to prevail.

Our country has a long history of accepting immigrants who have sought a better life. Sadly, recent federal

immigration policies have resulted in a massive overflow of migrants crossing our border, without being properly vetted.<sup>2</sup> In our state we've had an influx of more than 200,000 people who have come here, costing taxpayers \$1.9 billion last year.<sup>3</sup> Another \$2.4 billion cost<sup>4</sup> was passed in this year's budget.<sup>5</sup>

## Common sense needs to prevail. We must:

- **REPEAL** the Green Light Law, which allows anyone in New York State aged 16 or older to obtain a state-issued driver's license regardless of citizenship or lawful immigration status in the U.S. (A.5395)
- **RESTORE** and improve communication between federal immigration officials (ICE) and local law enforcement (A.8033, A.9167) and state agencies
- **PROTECT** communities by requiring local governments to opt-in to receiving migrants from other jurisdictions (A.8034)
- **SAFEGUARD** our schools, daycares and community organizations open to minors from becoming shelters for migrants (A.8013)
- **REQUIRE** proper safety background checks for all migrants (A.7319-A)
