Legislation Introduced By Assemblymember Demond Meeks that He and His State Colleagues Fought and Passed for the People of New York

Bill A10501 - This bill will establish a new Task Force on Social Media and Violent Extremism in the New York State Office of the Attorney General to study and investigate the role of social media companies in promoting and facilitating acts of violence, including hate crimes and domestic terrorism. It would also expand the protections against bias-related conduct under the Civil Rights Law to give the Attorney General greater authority to take action against such companies when they engage in targeted harassment or aid or incite any bias-related violence or intimidation.

"The fear felt throughout our state is so great that our families and residents can no longer feel safe in our schools, in our stores, or in our churches. Even now, these intolerant beliefs and hateful rhetoric are out there and accessible to millions online and through social media. We must take the pragmatic steps necessary today to mitigate the spread of these repulsive ideologies and safeguard the people of New York State from further pain and senseless violence. Together, it is our responsibility to keep our community safe."
