He introduced legislation to:

- prohibit contractors that have been disbarred from federal job sites from operating in New York to protect workers from their shady practices
- make information about job development programs, wages, employment and education more readily available so workers have the tools they need to succeed

He also helped:

- secure funding in this year's state budget for workforce development and adult education, including money for apprenticeships, the upstate Workforce Development Institute, summer youth employment and for Hillside Works
- pass a minimum wage increase so people working full time are able to provide for their families
- create a new paid family leave program so workers can take care of a newborn or sick loved one without sacrificing their paycheck
