## Programs to save you money

**Enhanced STAR** and the **Senior Citizens Homeowners' Exemption** provide much-needed property tax relief to thousands of eligible New Yorkers. Homeowners age 65 or older can apply through their local assessor's office.

## Assemblymember Bronson passed a state budget that:

### Looks out for your health and well-being

- ✓ Restores funding for Medicaid and other public health programs
- ✓ Ensures more New Yorkers are eligible for managed long-term care
- ✓ Helps ensure patients' nursing home beds are held if they're hospitalized
- ✓ Preserves spousal refusal so you don't lose your life savings if your spouse needs long-term care

### Helps you stay in your home

- ✓ Rejects changes to the Enhanced STAR program, ensuring that the property tax relief process remains simple
- ✓ Extends access to pre-foreclosure settlement conferences to homeowners with reverse mortgages



**Enhanced STAR** reduces the taxable value of your home, resulting in significant school tax savings. To be eligible, you must have a household income of less than \$86,000. More information can be found online at [www.tinyurl.com/EnhancedStar](http://www.tinyurl.com/EnhancedStar).

**Senior Citizens Homeowners' Exemption** reduces your home's assessed value by up to 50 percent. Applicants must have a household annual income of \$37,400 or less to become eligible.
