- Raised Medicaid reimbursement rates to 7.5%, the first rate increase in the last 15 years, and increased wages for home health care workers (2023-24 Budget)
- Passed A.1975 which requires services provided by marriage and family counselors, therapists, and psychoanalysis to be covered by commercial insurance carriers
- Passed A.6008-E of 2022 which gives licensed counselors and marriage and family therapists the ability to diagnose and create treatment plans
- Passed A.8702 of 2022 to allow services provided by licensed mental health counselors and marriage and family therapists eligible for coverage under Medicaid

- \$100 million secured for NY Forward to support sustainable growth in our towns, villages and rural communities (2023-2024 Budget)
- \$10 million in dedicated funding for redeveloping and enhancing the heart of Rochester through the Downtown Revitalization Initiative (DRI) (2023-2024 Budget)
 - \$4,000,000 in DRI Awards to transform the Main and Clinton Corner by redeveloping four buildings in Downtown Rochester to create middle income housing and modern store fronts
 - \$3,135,000 in DRI Awards to create 114 market rate housing units and 76 supportive housing units for survivors of domestic violence and makes improvements to neighboring St. Joseph's Park
 - \$1,300,000 in DRI Awards to construct the Main Street Commons and create new public space and improve amenities in the heart of downtown Rochester

- Expanded the state childcare program to include families earning up to 85% of the state median income and families earning up to 400% of the federal poverty level, making millions more New York families eligible (2023-24 state budget)
- Children under the age of 4 are now included in the Empire State Child Tax Credit (2023-24 state budget)
- Sponsored the Lead-Safe Renovation, Repair and Painting Act to minimize children's exposure to lead paint (A.434)
- Co-sponsored legislation to create the Children's Poverty Reduction Advisory Council (A.1160-C of 2022)
