

# 2021 LEGISLATIVE UPDATE: *NEWS THAT MATTERS TO YOU*



## Assemblyman Hawley voted NO on these harmful budget provisions.

- ✘ A 9.7% spending increase over last year's budget (making it the most expensive budget in New York's history)
- ✘ \$420 million film tax credit for Hollywood film producers (A.3009-C)
- ✘ A \$2.1 billion stimulus fund to give undocumented immigrants unemployment benefits with a maximum one-time payment of \$15,600 (A.3003-C)
- ✘ \$7.3 million to be spent on funding for political campaigns (A.3000-D)

## Assemblyman Hawley instead supported these important proposals, among many others:

- ✓ A bill that will grant members of Gold Star families free college tuition (A.7685)
- ✓ Legislation that would connect farmers and food banks to help them distribute excess meat, vegetables, dairy products, and other agricultural products to families in need (A.6391)
- ✓ A bill that would establish a small business tax credit for efforts taken to improve facilities to reduce the spread of infectious diseases like COVID-19 (A.03566)
