Albany has a history of restricting Second Amendment rights –from burdensome concealed-carry restrictions¹ to costly mandates that target law-abiding citizens² instead of those who break the law.

I am proud to sponsor and co-sponsor pro-Second Amendment legislation that would:

- ★ **Reform Firearm Licensing:**
Introduced legislation that would prohibit state-required warning statements in pistol permit applications, keeping licensing materials neutral and focused on the permitting process. (A.2402)
- ★ **Restore Civil Rights:**
Sponsored the Civil Rights Restoration Act that would repeal burdensome firearm licensing requirements, protect the privacy of law-abiding gun owners, and restore constitutional rights since the enactment of the SAFE Act. (A.2472)
- ★ **Protect Family Traditions:**
Allow certain firearms to be passed down through an estate to immediate family members. (A.894)
- ★ **Support Our Service Members:**
Streamline pistol permit applications for active military personnel. (A.3292)
- ★ **Reestablish Rights:**
Protect the rights of law-abiding New York residents by limiting SAFE Act restrictions to New York City. (A.2316)
- ★ **Fight Albany Overreach:**
Repeal the state's unnecessary background check fees on firearms and ammunition purchases. (A.3840)
