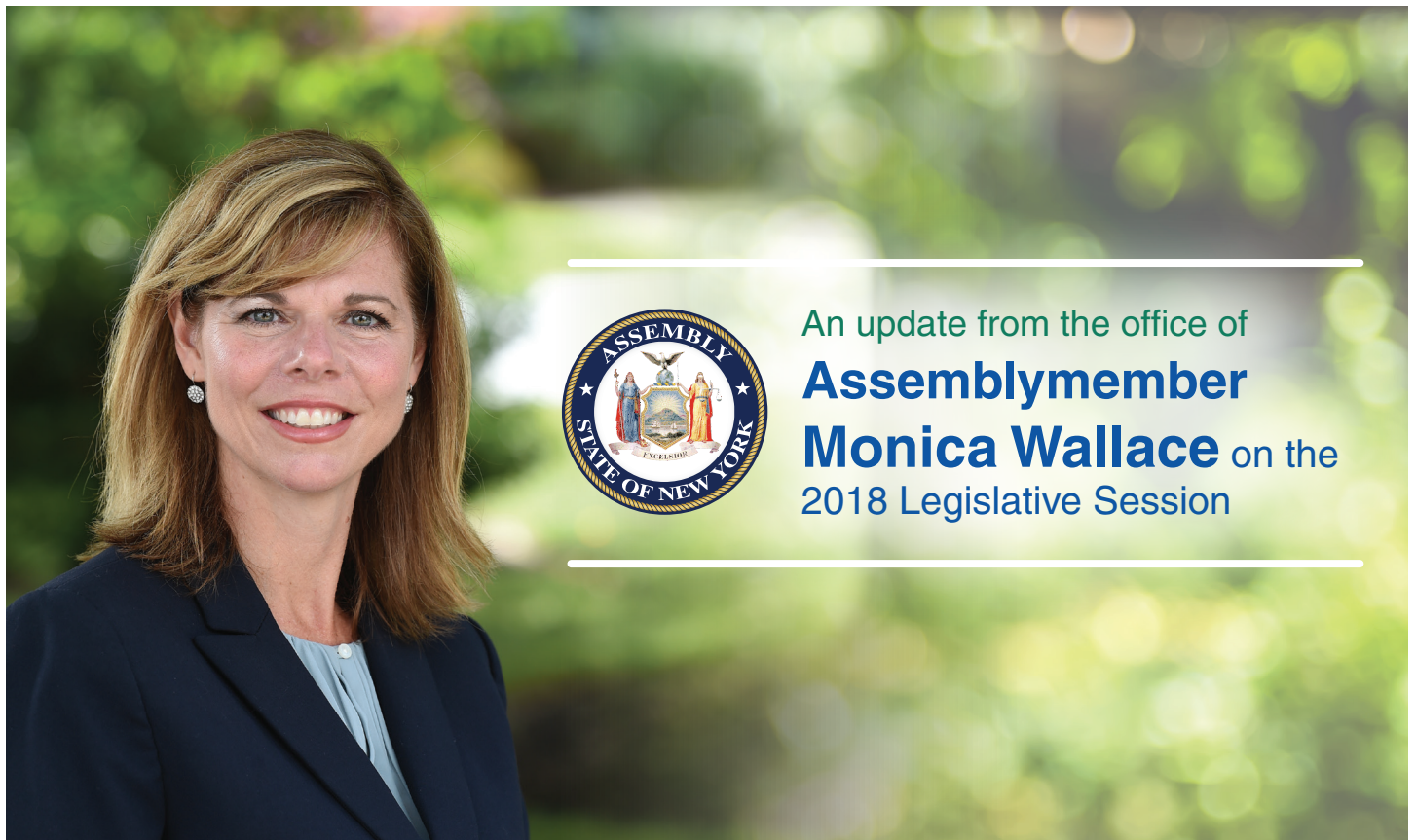

Wallace helped pass the following bills in the Assembly during the 2018 Legislative Session

Speaking up for veterans

As a member of the Veterans' Affairs Committee, Assemblymember Wallace has worked to increase benefits and expand services for those who have served our country.

- ✓ Authored legislation to ensure veterans and their spouses living in nursing homes and residential health care facilities are receiving the benefits they've earned (A.9981-A)
- ✓ Co-sponsored legislation to increase annuity payments for Gold Star Parents (A.2799-A)



Supporting volunteer firefighters

As chair of the Subcommittee on Volunteer Emergency Services, Assemblymember Wallace has advocated for those who protect our families.

- ✓ Sponsored legislation to make training for volunteer firefighters more accessible (A.10311-B)
- ✓ Helped create a "Lemon Law" for emergency vehicles to ensure manufacturers repair lifesaving equipment in a timely manner (A.10424)

Restoring integrity to government

Assemblymember Wallace has been a tireless champion of ethics reform and accountability.

- ✓ Introduced legislation to curtail "golden parachute" severance packages at taxpayer expense (A.10076)
- ✓ Sponsored legislation to increase transparency by giving citizens more time to comment on proposed agency rule changes (A.9643)
