Legislative Energy Report

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New York State must adopt a sensible energy policy ensuring short and long-term affordability and reliability. We can protect our environment and still allow customers the right to choose how they want to cook their food, heat their homes and drive their vehicles. *My plan includes:*

Immediate Relief

- Energy Price Rebate Checks – 3.4 million upstate residents could see over \$880 million in relief. (A.10394)
- Utility Bill Credits – Would return unused funds in NYSEERDA's Climate Investment Account. \$2.4 billion could rightfully be returned to ratepayers. (A.8876)

Protection From Costly Emergencies That Would:

- Reinvest in gas plants that generate almost 50% of the state's total electricity generation. (US Energy Information Administration, 2/29/26)
- Declare Energy Emergency to provide more safeguards for ratepayers, expedite new power generation to ensure reliability and stabilize prices.

Pursue All-Of-The-Above Strategy

- Secured the rollback of CLCPA and all-electric mandates. (A.10008C)
- Would complete a full cost benefit analysis of CLCPA goals. (A.6260, Chapter 58 of the Laws of NYS 2026)
- Responsibly embrace clean energy production by investing in nuclear, natural gas, hydrogen, renewable, and advanced technology sources.
