TIPS TO STAY SAFE THIS HAUGONIEUS

FOR TRICK-OR-TREATERS:

- Be visible and wear bright-colored costumes with reflective tape, and carry a flashlight or glow sticks to help motorists see you.
- Walk safely on sidewalks, use crosswalks, and walk in groups or with a trusted adult.
- Kids under 12 should be accompanied by an adult.
- Never enter a home or car for treats.
- Check candy for tampering or choking hazards.

FOR DRIVERS:

- Reduce your speed in residential areas and watch for children who may be crossing the street.
- Turn on your headlights and be especially careful at intersections.
- Scan the roads, medians, and curbs for trick-or-treaters, and look carefully when backing out of driveways.



FOR HOSTS AND HOMEOWNERS:

- Keep your house and walkway well-lit for trick-or-treaters.
- Make sure your yard and walkway are clear of tripping hazards.
- Keep family pets away from trick-or-treaters, even if they are friendly.
