ANGELO MORINELLO STANDS WITH THE WOMEN OF NEW YORK

IMPROVING HEALTHCARE FOR ALL WOMEN

- Passed Shannon's Law requiring all health insurance carriers to cover annual mammograms for women ages 35+. (S.3852-A)
- Provides help for eating disorders by requiring insurance providers to cover treatment. (A.1619)
- Expands Opioid Treatment Medication Coverage. (S.5935-A)
- Improves access to substance abuse treatments by removing pre-authorization for certain substance abuse treatment prescriptions. (A.2904)

QUALITY HEALTHCARE FOR MOMS

- Improves access to lactation counseling services. (S.3387)
- Develops obstetric hemorrhage protocols. (A.6962-A)
- Requires hospitals and birthing centers to share information about pregnancy complications and provide a referral list of services. (A.2957-A)

HELPING VETERAN WOMEN

- Reduces stigma around veteran mental health and substance abuse disorder issues and provides information on treatment and services. (A.2758-A)
- Successfully advocated to cover college costs for the children of military women (and men) killed or disabled while on duty. (A.2991)

PROTECTING WOMEN

- Criminalizes revenge porn. (A.5981)
- Helps domestic violence victims by requiring hospitals to identify and offer assistance and services to those who may be victims of domestic violence. (A.2850-A)
- Secures access to justice for sexual assault victims by extending the statute of limitations for sexual assault victims. (S.6574)
- Redefines rape to remove the penetration requirement. (A.794-C)
- Strengthened laws to combat human trafficking. (A.7591)

CLOSING THE PAY GAP

• Angelo voted for the law improving Equal Pay in New York (S.5248) and for fair compensation. (S.456-B)
