Assemblyman Joseph Giglio is working hard to help victims of violent crimes by sponsoring legislation increasing the time between parole hearings for violent offenders (A.2350). Victims and their families shouldn't be forced to relive their tragedies every 24 months to keep offenders behind bars. Denying parole for longer periods of time for violent offenders will give victims the time they need to heal. Giglio has also sponsored Brittany's Law (A.404), which creates and maintains a registry for violent felony offenders allowing the public access to a criminal's background history.
