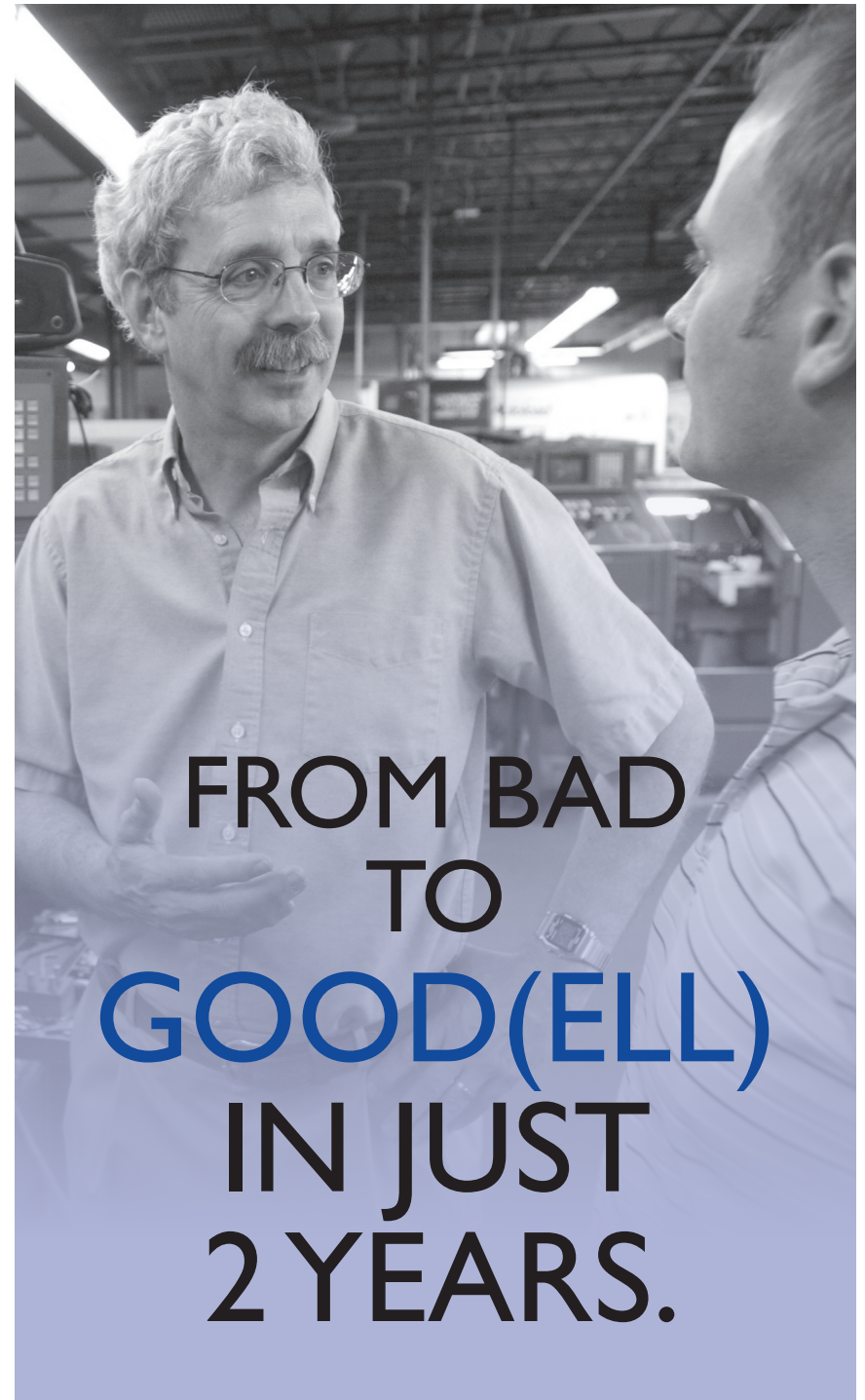


**2 YEARS BEFORE ANDY GOODELL:**

## SINCE ANDY GOODELL WENT TO ALBANY, STATE GOVERNMENT HAS:

- CUT INCOME TAX RATES for the middle class to the lowest rate in 58 years.
- PASSED TWO CONSECUTIVE ON-TIME BUDGETS, closing a \$13.5 billion budget gap without increasing taxes or imposing additional fees and gimmicks.
- LIMITED THE LOCAL SHARE OF MEDICAID and cut the cost to state and local government, reducing this unfunded mandate from the backs of county taxpayers.
- REINED IN THE SKYROCKETING COST OF PROPERTY TAXES by passing a property tax cap.
- RESTORED \$805 MILLION IN EDUCATION AID, including \$47 million for students with special needs.
- LOWERED THE COST OF LIVING by capping co-payments for prescriptions that seniors rely on.
- ENDED THE STATE SALES TAX ON CLOTHING for items under \$110.
