## ORAL TESTIMONY WILL BE BY INVITATION ONLY

On August 1, 2016, the New York State Public Service Commission approved the Clean Energy Standard (CES) (Case 15-E-0302), which established the goal of obtaining 50% of the state's electricity from renewable sources by 2030. A component of the CES is the twelve-year "Zero-Emissions Credit" (ZEC) requirement.

This hearing is an opportunity for the Assembly Committees on Corporations, Authorities, and Commissions; Consumer Affairs and Protection; Energy; and Environmental Conservation to explore the particulars of the order, the steps taken by the Commission that led up to its decision, and the specific terms of the ZEC requirement. The Committees will hear from the Public Service Commission and the New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA), and discuss ways to ensure transparency and public involvement are provided for in a decision-making process of this scale and impact.

Persons wishing to submit written testimony to the Committees for the above hearing should complete and return the enclosed reply form as soon as possible. It is important that the reply form be fully completed and returned so that persons may be notified in the event of emergency postponement or cancellation.

Fifteen copies of any prepared testimony should be submitted at the hearing registration desk. The Committees would appreciate advance receipt of prepared statements.
