SUBJECT: The Role of State Authorities in Renewable Energy Development

PURPOSE: To examine the role of State authorities in facilitating the development of renewable energy to meet the goals of the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act (CLCPA)

In 2019, the Legislature passed the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act, landmark legislation that set ambitious goals to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and expand the use of renewable energy technology in the State. The CLCPA was a critical step forward in addressing the climate crisis in our state, as well as making New York a national leader in addressing climate change. The CLCPA set a goal to attain an electric grid served by 70 percent renewable energy generation and a zero-emissions grid by 2040. State authorities will have a critical role in achieving renewable energy generation and transmission goals. The Committees on Corporations, Authorities and Commissions, Energy and Environmental Conservation will hear testimony on what role State authorities should have in meeting the goals of the CLCPA.

Persons wishing to present pertinent testimony to the Committees should complete and return the enclosed reply form as soon as possible. It is important that the reply form be fully completed and returned so that persons may be notified in the event of emergency postponement or cancellation. Oral testimony will be limited to three minutes' duration. In preparing the order of witnesses, the Committees will attempt to accommodate individual requests to speak at particular times in view of special circumstances. These requests should be made on the attached reply form or communicated to Committee staff as early as possible.

Written testimony should be submitted via email at least two days prior to the hearing. Participation will be limited and the Committees may close the list once the maximum number of reply forms has been received.

Attendees and participants at any legislative public hearing should be aware that these proceedings are video recorded. Their likenesses may be included in any video coverage shown on television or the internet.

In order to meet the needs of those who may have a disability, the Assembly, in accordance with its policy of non-discrimination on the basis of disability, as well as the 1990 Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), has made its facilities and services available to all individuals with disabilities.
